Background of Consultancy Request:

The UNICEF Education Section works with the Government of China, local partners, and communities to provide the country's most disadvantaged children with quality learning opportunities. We support government to strengthen China's education system so that it addresses the needs of the most excluded and vulnerable children, as well as ensure that girls and boys have equal access to opportunities. We also promote nurturing environments to support children develop into well-rounded individuals and facilitate smoother transition from school to work.

The Adolescents team in the Education Section works to support the Government of China improve access to quality education for 6–18-year-old. The 2021- 2025 education programming, aiming to facilitate the transition to a child-friendly education system, takes a holistic approach through seven inter-related projects ranging from child protection in schools, STEM education, life skills, sports, inclusive education, teacher training to social and emotional learning (SEL).

The 2021- 2025 education programming also embraces key strategic shifts with a renewed focus on upstream engagement and policy impact. It places greater emphasis on evidence-based policy and research, advocacy for children's rights and adaptation of international evidence to China's context (and vice versa). There will also be a shift from child-friendly schools to child-friendly education systems and scaling-up of adolescent programmes, particularly around integrating life skills into the technical and vocation education & training (TVET) reform process and expanding alternative learning pathways for out-of-school (OOS) adolescents in China.

The adolescent Education team therefore seeks a consultant with strong research and evaluation expertise to provide technical support to planned education research and evaluation activities.

Purpose of Activity/Assignment:

- 1. To support the Child-Friendly Schools evaluation (2001-2020) through coordination with the institutional contractor that has been commissioned to carry out the evaluation, including periodical technical review and expert input to the evaluation methodology, tools, data sources, technical analysis to ensure the evaluation complies with UNICEF standards, deliver intended outputs and produce quality insights.
- 2. To finalise the common M&E framework and baselines for the Child-Friendly Education Systems work (2021-25) including identifying sets of indicators and working with the education team to establish project baselines for the seven ongoing projects, conduct analysis and recommending



- adjustments to project designs, and conduct evaluability exercise for selected projects as requested.
- 3. To support the commissioning and implementation of educational researches as agreed with supervisor, including leading the technical input and review of research documents (concept note, TOR, methodology and outputs) and management of the research process as required.

- 3. Education Researches: agreed education reseraches (Social Emotional Learning, Life Skills and Out of School Adolescent etc) are commissioned, managed and completed to produce quality results and insights to inform education programming.

Master's degree in education, statistics, monitoring and evaluation, human resource development, international development or another related field. PhD degree is preferred.

- A least 3 years of practical experience in survey design using quantitative and qualitative methods, survey administration, analysis and reporting would be an asset

- Fluency in Chinese and English (both oral and written) is required.
