Purpose of Activity/Assignment:

The Sierra Leone Ministry of Basic and Senior Secondary Education and the Ministry of Technical and Higher Education have worked closely together in collaboration with other government agencies, development partners, civil society and non-governmental organizations, and regional and local stakeholders to develop and align behind a set of critical commitments to accelerate progress towards the agenda 2030 SDG 4 targets and to transform education. The Government has identified *Delivering the Foundations of Learning for All* as the priority reform that will be achieved through education system transformation in the country. The transformation will be done by addressing bottlenecks and working collaboratively with all stakeholders, partners, the Global Partnership for Education (GPE) and other donors. This is articulated and elaborated in the approved GPE partnership compact that serves as the basis to access GPE financing including: 1) System Capacity Grant (SCG): US\$ 2.6 million; 2) System Transformation Grant (STG): US\$ 22.5 million; and 3) GPE Multiplier Grant: US\$ 15 million.

The GPE compact highlights five pillars necessary to achieving the priority reform, which include focus on access to quality pre-primary education as well as strengthening and aligning teaching and learning to improve learning outcomes during the first four years of school. These pillars, identified on the basis of a root cause analysis and outlined in the compact's theory of change, are: (i) raise children's readiness to learn through targeted pre-primary education; (ii) strengthen the instructional core for foundational learning; (iii) train, recruit, retain and support excellent educators to deliver foundational learning; (iv) increase the use of data and technology to support foundational learning and educational service delivery; and (v) strengthen governance, management, and accountability for performance on foundational learning.

Ministry of Basic and Senior Secondary Education (MBSSE), in coordination with the Ministry of Technical and Higher Education (MTHE) and Sierra Leone Learning Education Group (SL-LEG) members, will be responsible for the "Foundations of Learning for All" reform, with the Teaching Service Commission (TSC) having a leading role in the formulation and provision of the in-service and continuous professional development initiatives for foundation level teachers.

UNICEF has been identified as the Grant Agent (GA) to access and support the implementation of all the three grants in Sierra Leone. Irish Aid is the co-ordinating agency in Sierra Leone.

It is against this background that UNICEF, in collaboration with the MBSSE, seeks to hire an international expert to provide technical assistance to collaboratively develop a comprehensive proposal for each of the three grants.

Purpose:

The purpose of the consultancy is to develop three comprehensive proposals for each of the GPE grants in consultation with MBSSE, MTHE, TSC, LEG, co-ordinating agency (Irish Aid) and experts to ensure synergy and mutual commitment among stakeholders in implementing the selected priority.

Objectives:

The specific objectives of this assignment are to:

- 1. Review key strategic and policy documents to ensure the alignment and complementarity of the proposals.
- 2. Facilitate consultations with MBSSE, MTHE, TSC, LEG members and experts as part of the process to identify and cost strategies and plans, as well as identify a pathway for sustainability beyond the grants' life.
- 3. Draft and finalize each of the three proposals for STG, SCG and Multiplier Grant, using GPE templates while ensuring feedback from all stakeholders are included, in developing the strategy for achievement of the committed indicators for the programme.

Scope of Work:

Scope of the consultancy

The selected candidate working closely with MBSSE, MTHE, TSC teams, development partners, other relevant stakeholders and experts; will ensure alignment and harmonization with national priorities, complementarity between the three grants and other stakeholders' support; by leading the following tasks:

a. Review key strategic documents

The key documents include:

- The enabling factors for systemic change in education,
- Education Sector Analysis: Assessing the Enabling Environment for Gender Equality (2021),
- Partnership Compact 2022-2026: Foundations of Learning for All
- Education Sector Plan: Transforming Learning for All (2022-2026),
- Freetown Gender transformative manifesto 2022,
- Other relevant policy documents.

The expected outcome is to develop a revised roadmap and methodology for the proposals' development and a draft outline of the grant applications. These deliverables are to be presented for fine tuning during the consultations.

b. Facilitate consultations with education stakeholders

Consultant shall consult partners to identify focus areas and appropriate strategies to achieve the targets in a coherent fashion. These consultations can be virtual and/or in person. Bilateral meetings will be required to collect additional feedback from stakeholders. These consultations shall create opportunities for dialogues on key issues and priorities that can directly or indirectly affect the programme implementation. The key deliverable is to prepare comprehensive proposals documenting key bottlenecks and priorities for achieving system transformation and supporting strategies to achieve milestones.

c. Draft and finalize the three proposals

Following the consultations, the consultant shall draft the three proposals based on the GPE proposed guidelines and outlines and GPE compact document. The draft document shall go through proper validation channels agreed by MBSSE, MTHE, UNICEF, Coordinating agency (Irish Aid) and GPE. Once a draft is presented and finalized at country level it will be shared with the GPE country team for feedback. Further the consultant will finalize the proposals using the relevant templates to be submitted to the GPE board for approval. The expected outcome is the finalized full proposals for the three GPE grants.
