

Evaluation Criteria for a Consultancy to pilot an assessment tool for benchmarking policy support for universal parenting

The selection criteria for the candidates will be based, among other criteria, on compliance with the requirements indicated in these terms of reference and will be calculated as follows: the technical evaluation will have a value of 75%, and the economic evaluation will have a value of 25%.

The technical evaluation of the interested candidates will be based on (75%):

Updated resumé

where they explicitly demonstrate the requirements of the profile in accordance with this call (max. 3 pages). The resúmes must include three work references (name, email and contact telephone number). The references can be sent in a separate document. The resumé will have a value of 35%.

- An advanced university degree (Master's and above) in one of the following areas is required: law, international relations, human rights, etc. or a related social field (Comply 5%, Not comply 0).
- A minimum of five to ten years of relevant professional work experience in social policy-related field, with expertise in parenting, early childhood development (ECD) and/or social welfare fields: (Comply 10%; Partially Comply 5%; Not comply 0).
- A minimum of 5 years of experience related working for children and/or families in need of protective services (violence against children, gender- based violence, etc.). (Comply 10%, Partially Comply 5%; Not comply 0).
- Experience facilitating workshops/roundtables or trainings (Comply 10%; Partially Comply 5%; Not comply 0).

Technical note

(max.3pages), with a proposed work plan that includes a theoretical-conceptual framework, methodology and work schedule, as well as any other element necessary for the development of the consultancy. The technical note will be examined by the selection committee together with the information on the experience and technical skills of the candidates: 40%

- Workplan and schedule: (Comply 20%, Partially Comply 10%; Not comply 0).
- Theoretical-conceptual framework about parenting, ECD, social welfare and the methodology to pilot the benchmarking assessment tool: (Comply 20%, Partially Comply 5%; Not comply 0).

Economic Proposal (25%):

The economic proposal will be evaluated with the following formula: Lowest economic proposal multiplied by 25%, divided by the proposal to be evaluated.

The project/contract will be assigned to the candidate who obtains the best global rating of the sum of both evaluations, technical and economic (cumulative analysis). Work references checking will be made to the selected candidate.
