Technical Assistance to support quality ECD implementation in four NTT districts	Consultant should be home-based and will not have assigned desk or office space.

Purpose of Activity/Assignment:

To provide technical assistance to support the Kupang Field office in ensuring quality implementation of the Early Childhood Development (ECD) programme in four districts in East Nusa Tenggara namely; Rote Ndao, Manggarai Barat, Sumba Timur and Sumba Barat Daya

Background and Justification:

Quality pre-primary education is the foundation of a child's journey such that every stage of education that follows relies on quality early learning. In low-income countries, the picture is bleaker, with only 1 in 5 young children enrolled. Children from poor families are the least likely to attend early childhood education and development programmes. Failure to provide quality early childhood education limits children's futures by denying them opportunities to reach their full potential. It also limits the futures of countries, robbing them of the human capital needed to reduce inequalities and promote peaceful, prosperous societies.

Children enrolled in at least one year of pre-primary education are more likely to develop the critical skills they need to succeed in school and less likely to repeat grades or drop out. As adults, they contribute to peaceful societies and prosperous economies. Evidence of the ways in which pre-primary education advances development exists around the world. In NTT context, based on SUSENAS (2021) UNICEF indicated that children who do not attend ECD centres have higher proportion of being unable to read in the primary school than children who attend ECD centres. This explains that participating in ECD centre is significantly supporting children's readiness to successfully transition to primary school level.

NTT province provides the 7th largest ECD services in Indonesia by the number of students, teachers and ECD centres (Dapodik, 2023). However, the total number of 153,000 children who attend in ECD centres in NTT only represents 2.3% of children aged 3-6 for ECD nationally. Bureau Statistics (2023) records that (net) enrolment of children to Early Childhood Development (ECD) centre in NTT is only 31,7 % which is below than national rate 34.8 %. Beside lower participation in ECD centres, there is also an issue of ECD teachers' insufficiency in NTT. With the number of 11,000 ECD teachers to serve in 5,800 ECD centres, meaning, averagely in one ECD centre has only one to two teachers. ECD teachers' background in NTT is also a concern, given that 45% are not university-graduate. This contribute to the low reading and numeracy foundational skills of NTT children in grade four of primary school level which is only 35% for reading and 25% for math skills of students who have basic skills in respective aspects ¹.

The COVID-19 pandemic has resulted in widespread disruption to education and essential services for children, with the closure of country's 530,000 schools, affecting over 60 million students and 3.3 million ECE students. Ministry of Education' assessment (2022) in 5,965 ECD centres in East Nusa Tenggara on non-education eight essential indicators of HI ECD at ECD centres records that the indicators' performance is 72 out of 100. This means that in average ECD centres in NTT applied five to six out of eight essential indicators of HI ECD at ECD centres. Services regarding the supplementary food provision, children identity and unavailable of sanitation facilities at ECD centres are less provided.

Given the impacts of the pandemic on early learning and development services, it is crucial to support ECD centres in a safe and healthy resumption of in-person learning after the pandemic. Every effort must be made to ensure children optimally achieve their development potential, regardless of the circumstances. A focus on expanding

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quality ECD programme, including learning interventions, and promoting school readiness and transition, parenting programmes to cover children essential services (including nutrition, health, immunizations and child protection) and practices by caregivers, including teachers, are important investments that will help to to achieve meaningful results for children in East Nusa Tenggara.

Given this context, UNICEF is seeking to recruit a national consultant to work with district governments and ECD educators to promote a healthy, quality and safe ECD learning environment and to support the replication and scaleup of the quality ECD across districts in East Nusa Tenggara. This consultant will work under the management of UNICEF Kupang Field Office with a direct supervision of UNICEF's Education Officer in Kupang Field Office.

Scope of Work:

Technical support to institutionalize, scale-up, and sustain good practices and approaches developed so
far under the ECD programme in Rote Ndao, West Manggarai, East Sumba and South West Sumba.
Technical assistance will be provided to the district governments to continue raising awareness of the
importance of HI-ECD, the role of cross-sectoral coordination through the HI-ECD Taskforce, and the
development of district/provincial policies, guidelines, and action plans to strengthen quality. The
insertion of HI ECD and literacy and numeracy in the District Mid-Term Development Plan (RPJMD) will be
instrumental to promote ongoing sustainability and institutionalisation.

Output 1: Report on the development of HI ECD Bupati regulations, Task Force and District Action Plan on HI ECD in target districts. The inclusion of HI ECD in the District Mid-Term Development Plan (RPJMD) and annual workplan and budget (RENJA).

Technical support to supervise and monitor HI-ECD activities in ECD centres. Technical support to
systematically monitor activities will be provided to ECD centres to ensure quality service delivery
including play-based learning, teacher and students' vaccination, nutrition status detection, healthy and
hygienic environment and behaviour and children identity administration.

Output 2: Report on improving implementation of educational and non-educational eight essential indicators of HI ECD at ECD centres in target districts; Three Human Interest Stories outlining good practices and innovation.

 Providing technical expertise and assistance in teacher's training in introducing the implementation of new Merdeka Curriculum, play based methodology, joyful transition from pre-primary to primary education, children's essential needs, parent and caregiver engagement, etc to improve the teacher's knowledge and skill in nurturing young children.

Output 3: Report on training of Quality ECD outlining improved mindset, knowledge set, and skill set of ECD educators (principals and teachers) in target districts on the updated curriculum, learning methodology, school transition and HI ECD.
