Purpose of Activity/Assignment:

The Government of Indonesia (GoI) is committed to Early Childhood Development (ECD), as reflected in the 2013 Presidential Regulation on Holistic Integrated Early Childhood Development (HI-ECD), to which UNICEF has provided substantial policy advice and technical support. Since the issuance of the Regulation, the GoI has launched the "National Action Plan on Holistic and Integrated ECD" in line with the Sustainable Development Goal (SDG) Target 4.2 – ensuring that all girls and boys have access to quality early childhood development, care and pre-primary education so that they are ready for primary education. Assisting the GoI in achieving SDG Target 4.2 is one of the key components of the current UNICEF-Government of Indonesia Country Programme for 2021-25; and was a focus in the previous country programme cooperation partnership from 2016-20.

UNICEF continued to be a key partner to the GoI, especially Ministry of Education, Culture, Research and Technology (MoECRT), in developing a quality approach to the delivery of early learning and development services. The approach focuses on the holistic and integrated development of early childhood education (ECE) centres (Pendidikan Anak Usia Dini–PAUD) by enhancing teachers' capacity, developing a mentoring system for teacher, providing healthy, safe and conducive learning environments and engaging and empowering parents to support children's learning and development at home. In the current Country Programme, this model will be further institutionalized and scaled-up through intensive policy advocacy at provincial level together with capacity development support in 60 districts, focusing on eastern Indonesia, where the need for holistic and integrated early childhood education (HI ECD) is greatest. As HI ECD is implemented with reference to the nurturing care framework, the work is cross-sectoral in nature, including key components on early learning, health, nutrition, caregiving, and child protection.

To date, UNICEF has advocated for corresponding policy changes to facilitate the provision of HI ECD services; and is assisting the GoI in replicating the HI ECD approach with its own resources. Current major activities UNICEF is working with the GoI to progress include:

- 1. The MoECRT in piloting holistic ECD interventions by improving coverage and quality of community based ECD centres and kindergartens in 50 districts.
- 2. The Ministry of National Development Planning (Bappenas) has developed and promulgated the National Action Plan and Technical Guideline for HI ECD implementation.
- 3. Statistics Indonesia (BPS) in adapting the Early Childhood Development Index (ECDI2030) as the child developments measurement for children age 24-59 months, to be used in national household survey.
- 4. The National Population and Family Planning Agency (BKKBN) in developing and testing the Social Behaviour Change Communication (SBCC) for the parenting programme and Financial Literacy Module implementation for parents with children 0-6 years of age in West Papua.

To support the roll-out of HI ECD programmes across several districts, with a focus on optimizing the sustainability of UNICEF's support to GoI, UNICEF is seeking to recruit an individual national consultant. The national consultant will also support some activity planning and dialogue at the national level in support of this work.



Scope of Work:

The support areas include:

- 1. Technical input into the development of teaching and learning materials to support effective transition to primary school and for catch-up learning during the COVID-19 pandemic, with a focus on pre-literacy and pre-numeracy, with MoECRT.
- 2. Technical support for the development of the ECDI2030 instrument adaptation into the national household survey with BPS.
- 3. Support the partnership and programme document development with the Coordinating Ministry of Human Development and Cultural Affairs (Kemenko PMK) for HI-ECD coordination at the national level, including liaison with other relevant sectoral programmes with UNICEF.
- 4. Coordinate and provide technical guidance for the implementation and replication of HI-ECD in 8 districts across 3 provinces based on an agreed detailed programme implementation plan. Assisting with coordination activities with WASH, health, nutrition and child protection sections will be an important part of this work.
